Stone Altar for St. Malachy's

When our new church was dedicated in 1985 it was decided that, due to limited financial resources, a wooden altar would be used in the sanctuary of the church. The Church's directives regarding the construction and furnishing of church buildings suggest that an altar should be fixed and, whenever possible, made of stone. Recently Sacred Heart Church in Ayrshire was closed, and the Diocese began the process of finding a new home for the stone altar that was dedicated in 1981 just a few years before St. Malachy's was built. We have discussed this at the Parish Council, and we have decided that we would like to accept the stone altar from Ayrshire and use it to replace our 'temporary' wooden altar. While we do not have an exact timeframe for the transfer of this stone altar, we will keep you posted as the project progresses.
